

**HOLIDAY VISITS**

**\*\* Inmates in Phase I are not allowed holiday visits\*\***

Inmates in Phase II are allowed the following five (5) holiday visits per year for all custody levels:

- New Years Day Sat / Sun - December 30/31, 2023
- Mother's Day Sat / Sun - May 20/21, 2023
- Father's Day Sat/ Sun - June 17/18, 2023
- Independence Day Sat / Sun - July 01/02, 2023
- Veterans Day Sat / Sun - November 11/12, 2023

Inmates in Phase III are allowed the five (5) Holiday Visits listed above, as well as, the following two (2) Holiday Visits listed below for all custody levels:

- Valentine's Day Sat / Sun - February 10/11, 2024
- Labor Day Sat / Sun - September 02/03, 2023

Regular visitation periods will be in four-hour blocks each weekend, from 0800 to 1200 hours and 1200 to 1600 hours. Frequencies for regular visitation and food visitation will be based on the inmate's phase level.

**FOOD VISIT REGULATIONS**

Permissible food items shall be pre-cooked and/or properly prepared prior to arrival, wrapped in plastic or wax paper, or stored in a plastic see-through container. Visitors shall provide their own plastic bags/containers. These items will not be provided by the units. Families shall provide all food for the food visits, either home cooked or purchased by the family.

All food containers and utensils must fit into one ice chest/ container no larger than 25-quart size and must be able to clear the metal detector. All contents of all coolers must be physically searched.

No more than two different groups of visitors may visit the same inmate at the same time. No more than one ice chest/ containers may be with an entire group of visitors during the visit.

No food shall be cut on-site. All food must be cut and pre-packaged into serving portions prior to arrival.

**Prohibited items are as follows:**

- ▶ Glass / Metal / Non see-through containers
- ▶ Appliances of any type
- ▶ All food not consumed during the visit shall be removed by the visitor.
- ▶ No beverages, beverage powders, tea or coffee shall be brought into visitation on food visit days. Beverages may be purchased in the visitation area.
- ▶ Cardboard food boxes of any type, such as pizza, etc. .

**FOOD PREP GUIDE**

**\*\*\*Paper plates and paper cups only\*\*\***

Meat	Must be prepared and properly packed prior to entering the Unit. Meat shall be deboned, sliced, shredded, diced or minced.
Salad	Dressing made be brought in a separate see-through plastic container.
Vegetables	Shall be shredded, sliced or diced. No corn-on-the-cob, but corn may be brought in a see-through plastic container.
Baked Potatoes	Shall be cut in half prior to entering the unit.
Fruits	Shall be peeled and quartered / sliced. No whole fruit will be permitted with exception of small fruit such as grapes, cherries or berries.
Casseroles	Pre-cooked and in serving portions.
Tamales	Must be husked and cut in half.
Bread	Must be pre-sliced.
Cheese	Must be sliced or grated.
Pie / Cake	Must be pre-cut into serving portions.
Ice Cream	Must be in an original sealed / unopened container not to exceed one pint per person.
Ice	Limited to one bag. Ice may be kept in the bag or loose in the cooler.
Pre-packaged chips	Must be transferred into a clear plastic container or bag.
Utensils	Forks & Spoons only; shall be lightweight and disposable (plastic).

**Inmates can purchase up to four (4) photos at \$1.00 per photo during the scheduled photo session. Withdrawal forms due two weeks prior to the scheduled photo date.**

## EARNED INCENTIVE PROGRAM

The Earned Incentive Program is a system of graduated rewards and sanctions encouraging inmates to practice pro-social and responsible behavior throughout their sentence. A pro-social lifestyle is more than complying with rules. It encompasses program completions, following medical and mental health directives, fulfilling restitution requirements, participating in restorative justice activities and improving relationships with self and others. Each Inmates Correction Plan shall be tailored to their specific risk, needs and time serve and includes all facets of their daily life. Inmates who make decisions, solve problems and be held accountable commensurate with their custody level for the duration of their incarceration.

**Regular visitation periods will be in four-hour blocks each weekend, from 0800 to 1200 hours and 1200 to 1600 hours. Frequencies for regular visitation and food visitation will be based on the inmate's phase level .**

### Google Meet Video Visits

- Google Meet™ Video visitation shall be permitted for eligible inmates through use of approved, state-sponsored visitation tablets.
- Limited to one 30-minute video visit per week, per inmate.
- Available for inmates who are Phase I, II, III and either on Contact or Non-Contact status.
- In addition to other visitation and is not reflected in the total number of blocks.
- All Google Meet™ video visits are by appointment only by phone, or by using the Online Scheduling system (Once Hub).

### FOOD VISITS

**Phase I inmates are not eligible for food visits and will not be permitted to visit during a food visit weekend.**

**Holiday food visits shall be limited to one four-hour block per inmate.**

Upon Availability, inmates and inmate visitors may order meals through the approved vendor. Approved vendor meals shall be pre purchased prior to the visitation day. Inmates and inmate visitors may order one meal per person, per day. Vendor approved meals are available for all inmate custody levels except Maximum custody, and on the approved food visit according to the inmate's phase.

## Minimum Custody

### Phase I Inmates:

Will have one (1) Google meet video visit per week.

Will have one (1) 4 hour blocks each weekend.

### Phase II Inmates:

Will have three (3) 4 hour blocks each weekend.

Will have one (1) 4 hour weekday visit.

Will have one (1) Google meet video visit per week.

Will have four (4) 30 min. block per day with a max of 4 blocks per week for Securus Video visits.

### Phase III Inmates:

Will have four (4) 4 hour blocks each weekend.

Will have one (1) 4 hour weekday visit.

Will have one (1) Google meet video visit per week.

Will have four (4) 30 min. block per day with a max of 4 blocks per week for Securus Video visits.

## Closed Custody

### Phase I Inmates:

Will have one (1) Google meet video visit per week.

Will have one (1) 4 hour blocks each weekend.

### Phase II Inmates:

Will have two (2) 4 hour blocks each weekend.

Will have one (1) 2 hour weekday visit.

Will have one (1) Google meet video visit per week.

Will have four (4) 30 min. block per day with a max of 4 blocks per week for Securus Video visits.

### Phase III Inmates:

Will have three (3) 4 hour blocks each weekend.

Will have one (1) 2 hour weekday visit.

Will have one (1) Google meet video visit per week.

Will have four (4) 30 min. block per day with a max of 4 blocks per week for Securus Video visits.

**Closed Custody Inmates in Phase III:** will receive two (2) Food Visits a year.

**Minimum Custody Inmates in Phase II:** will receive two (2) Food Visits a year.

**Minimum Custody Inmates in Phase III:** will receive three (3) Food Visits a year.

## Food Visit Schedule

**Inmates will only visit on the day (Saturday or Sunday) of the weekend that is that is associated with the first initial of their last name. This will rotate every other food visit. Exceptions to be made by the unit Deputy Warden. Please see the below listed schedule.**

### Valentine's Day Food Visit :

February 17 & 18, 2024 - Apache & Coronado (**Phase III Only**)

(Saturday M-Z / Sunday A-L)

### Mother's Day Food Visit :

May 13 & 14 2023 - Apache & Coronado (**Phase II & Phase III**)

May 13 & 14, 2023 - Kaibab (**Phase III Only**)

(Saturday A-L / Sunday M-Z)

### Father's Day Food Visit :

June 24 & 25, 2023 - Apache & Coronado (**Phase II & Phase III**)

June 10 & 11, 2023 - Kaibab (**Phase III Only**)

(Saturday M-Z / Sunday A-L)

**It is the responsibility of the inmate to notify visitors of any change in Phase / Visitation status.**
