



MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month


COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADC HAS RELEASED 1,673 INMATES FY 2011 YEAR TO DATE






