



**MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE**




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month


**COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION**

**ADC HAS RELEASED 15,341 INMATES FY 2010 YEAR TO DATE**






