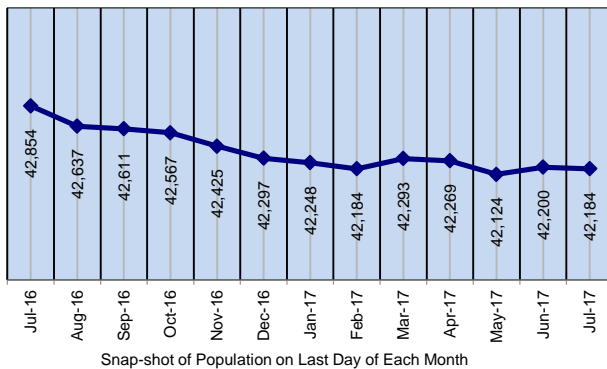

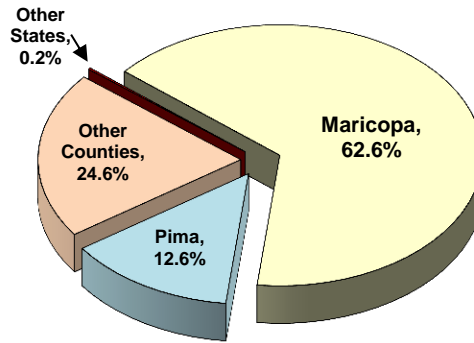

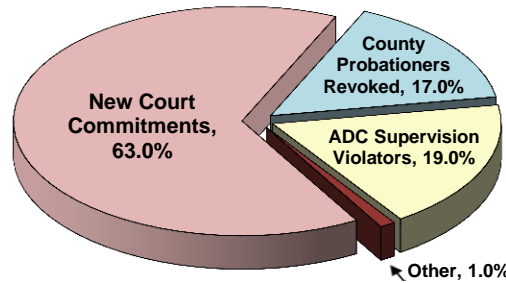
**MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE**



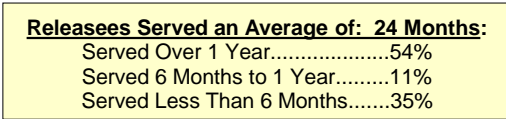
**COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION**

**ADC HAS RELEASED 1,507 INMATES FY 2018 YEAR TO DATE**



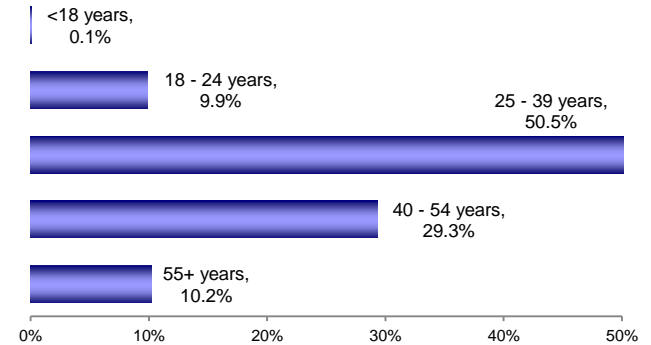

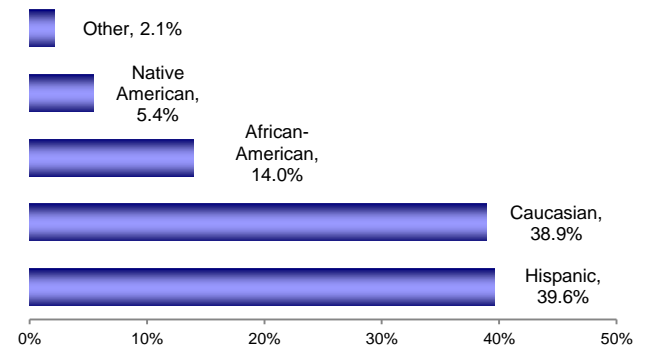

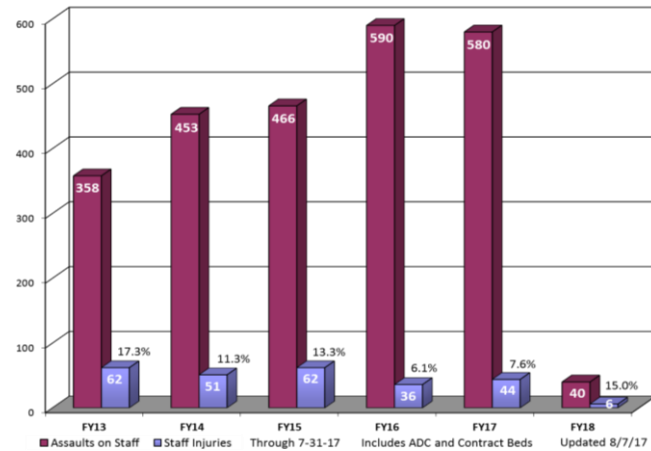
**AGE DISTRIBUTION**
