



MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month


COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADC HAS RELEASED 6,270 INMATES FY 2018 YEAR TO DATE






CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION


AGE DISTRIBUTION
