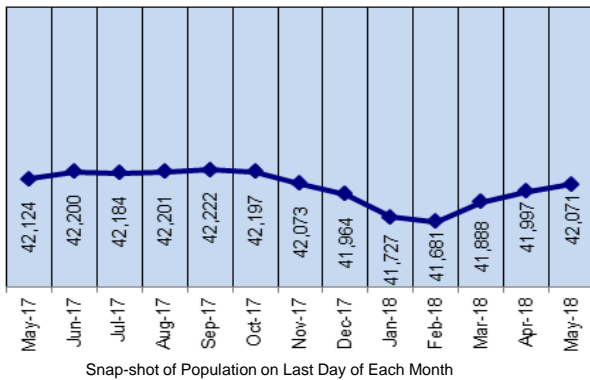

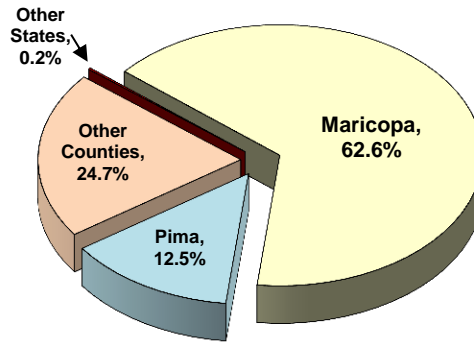

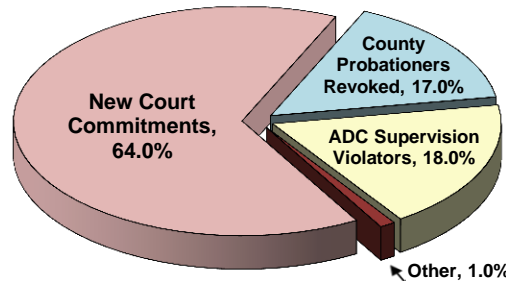
MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE



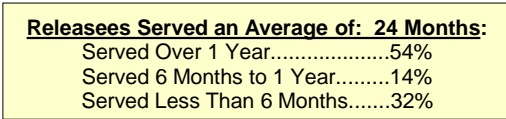
COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADC HAS RELEASED 16,918 INMATES FY 2018 YEAR TO DATE



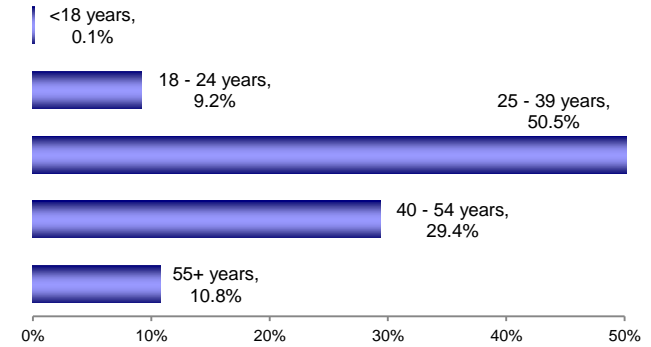

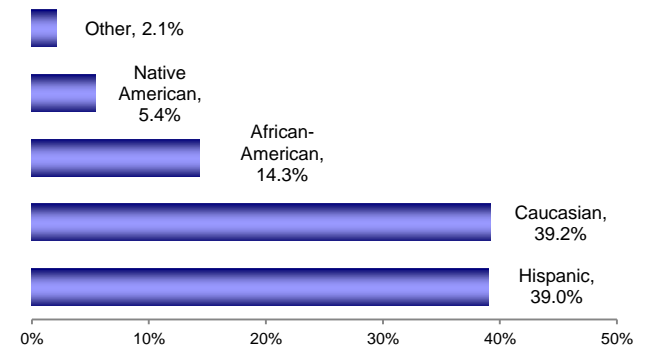
CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION

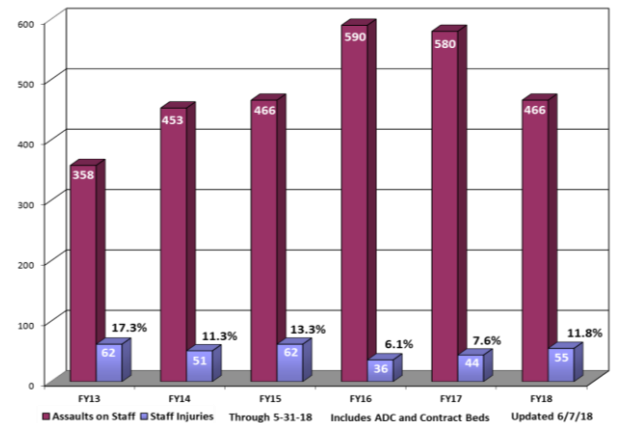
AGE DISTRIBUTION
