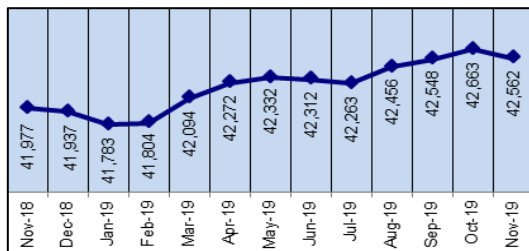

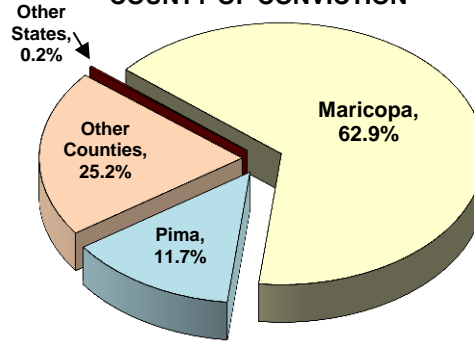

MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE

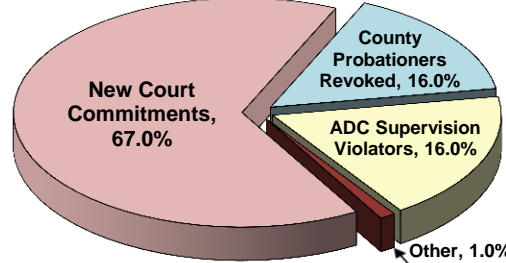


Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

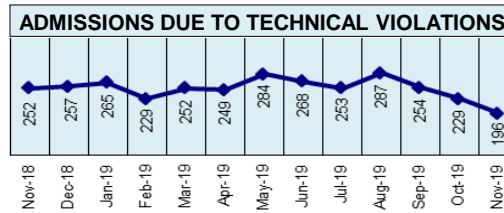
COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

***ADC HAS RELEASED 7,449 INMATES FY 2020 YEAR TO DATE**



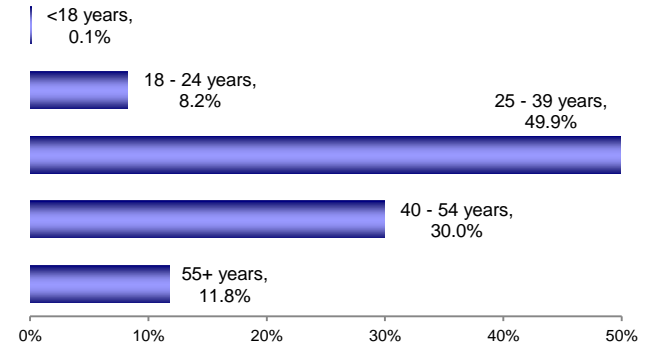

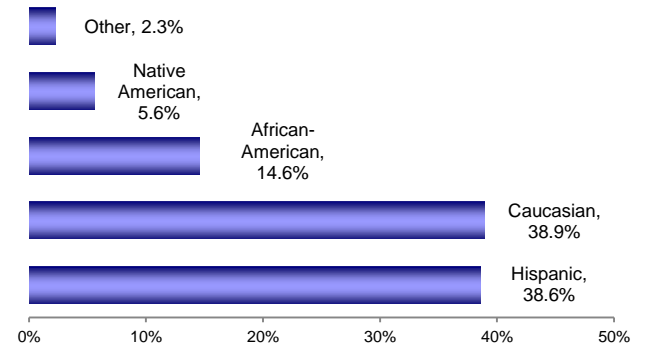
CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION

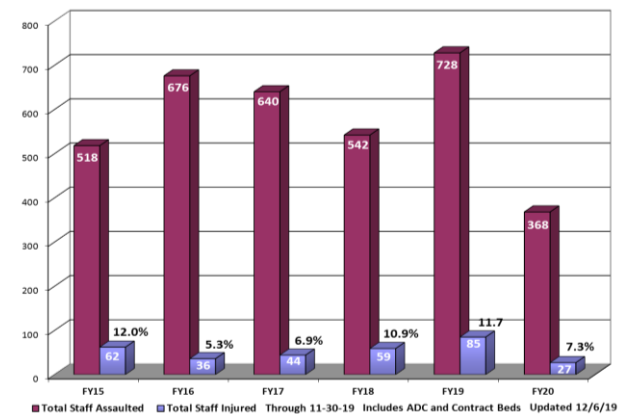
AGE DISTRIBUTION
