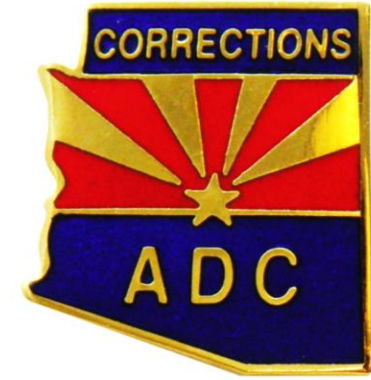

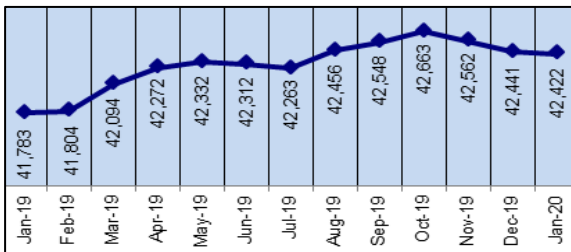

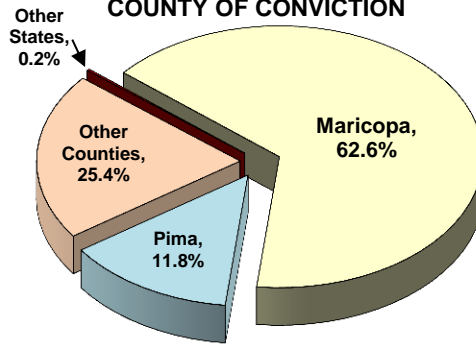

MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE

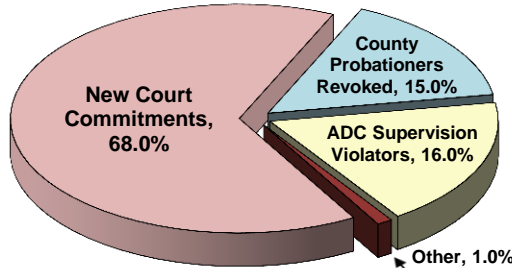


Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

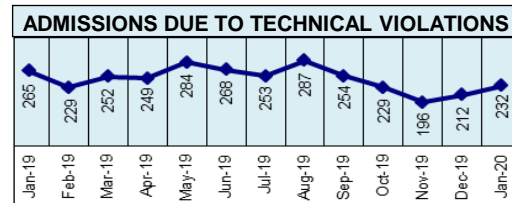
COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

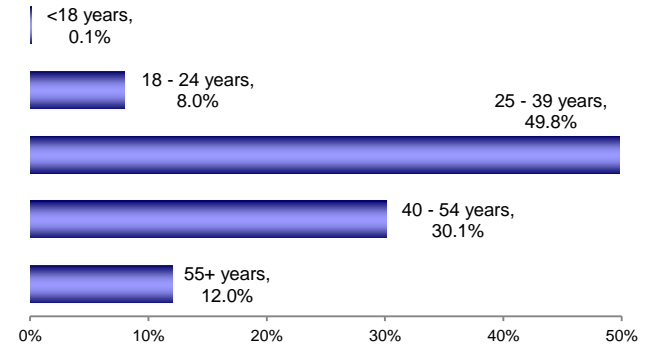

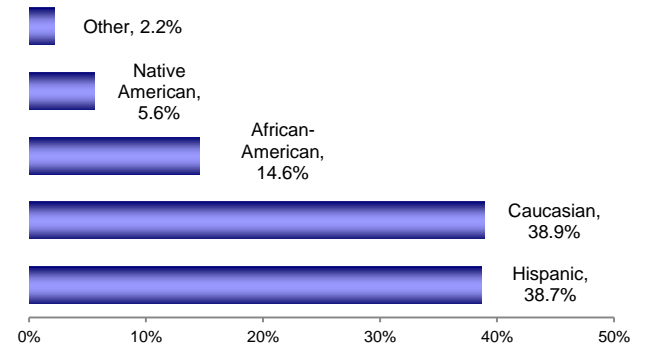

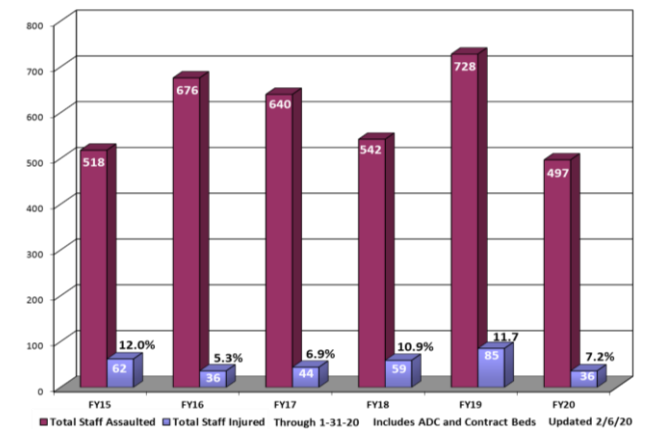
AGE DISTRIBUTION
