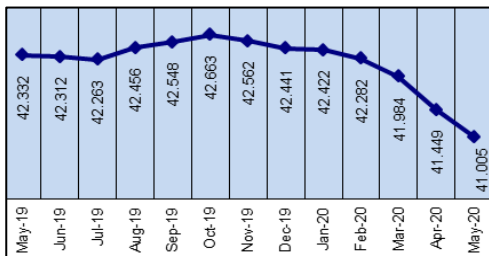

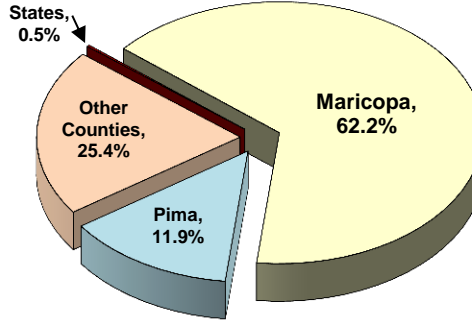

MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE

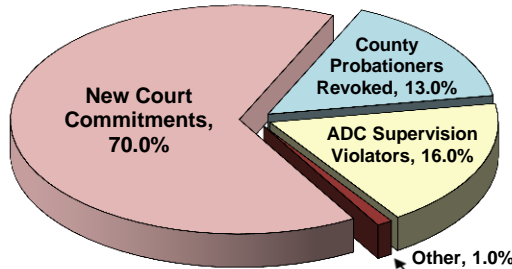


Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

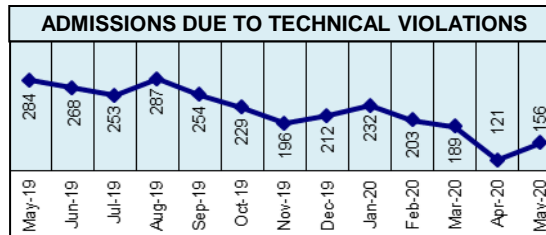
COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADCRR HAS RELEASED 16,208 INMATES FY 2020 YEAR TO DATE



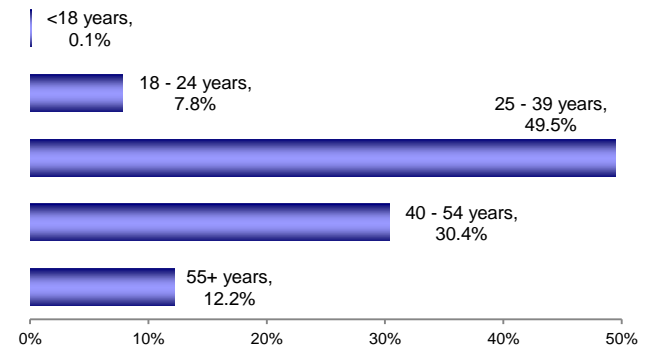

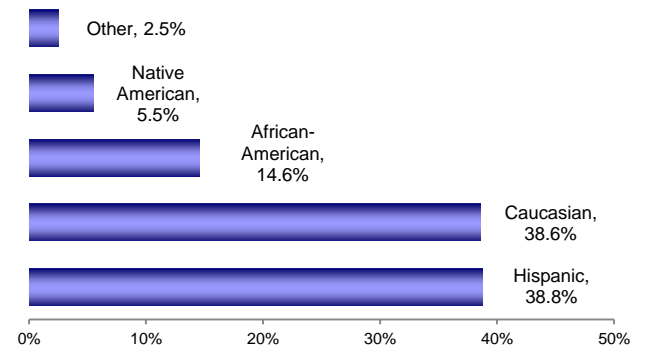
CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION

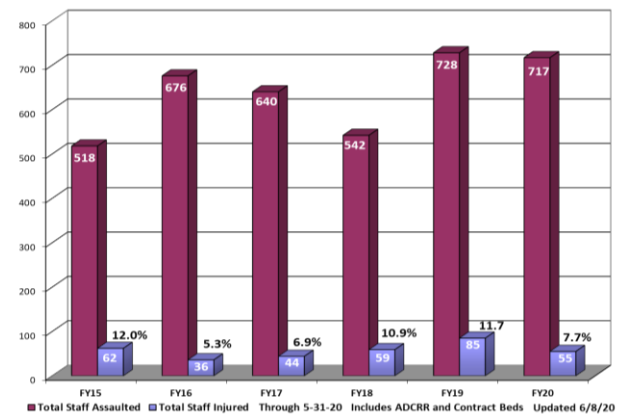
AGE DISTRIBUTION
