

**MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE**




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

**COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION**




**ADC HAS ADMITTED 8,226 INMATES FY 2014 YEAR TO DATE**


