



MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION




ADC HAS ADMITTED 6,575 INMATES FY 2014 YEAR TO DATE

ASSAULTS ON ADC STAFF - WITH INJURY




