Assessment results, along with sentence structure, are used to prioritize inmate programmatic goals and placement. *These figures represent a snapshot in time and do not include inmates who have already completed the programs.*

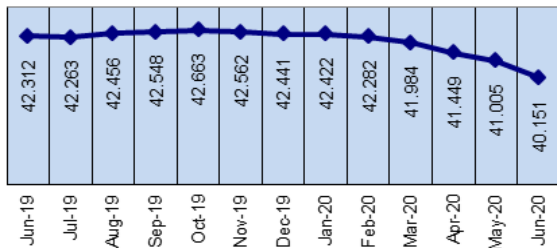

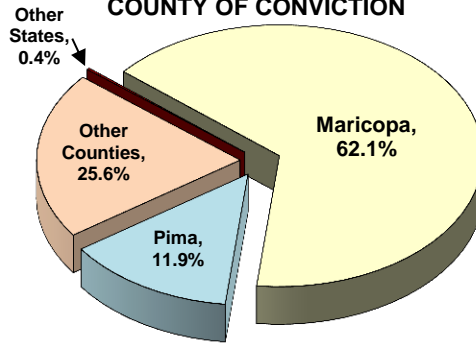

MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE

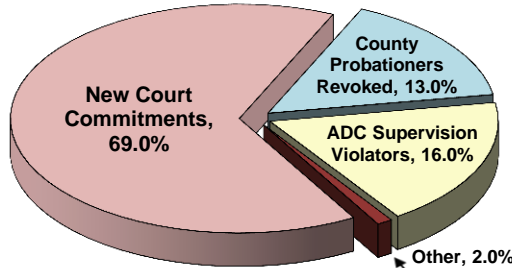


Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

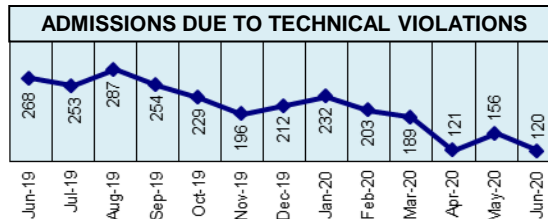
COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADCRR HAS RELEASED 17,641 INMATES FY 2020 YEAR TO DATE



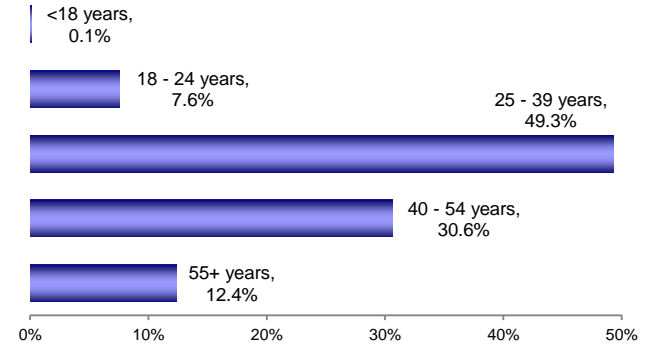

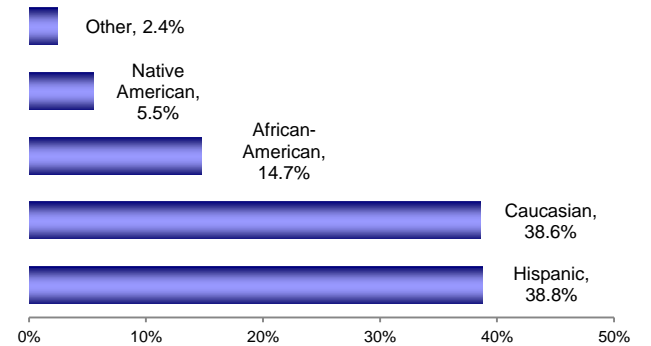
CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION

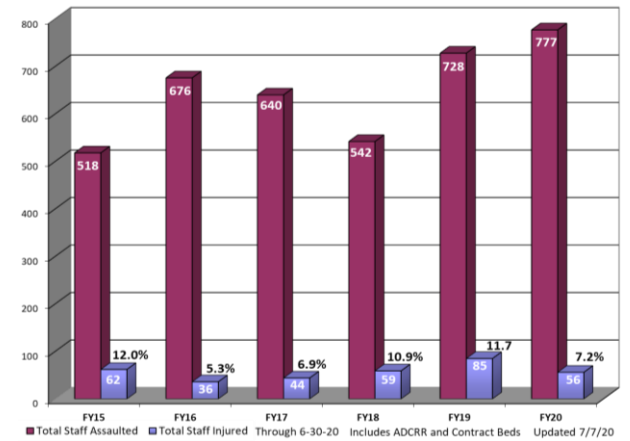
AGE DISTRIBUTION
