

Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month


COMMITTED POPULATION BY **COUNTY OF CONVICTION**




CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION

ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION




TOTAL STAFF ASSAULTED PER 1000 INMATES
