



MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE




Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month


COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADCRR HAS RELEASED 8,538 INMATES FY 2024 YEAR TO DATE







ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION




TOTAL STAFF ASSAULTED PER 1000 INMATES
