SUBJECT: Director's Instruction # 317, Standardized Closed Circuit Television System

This Director's Instruction is effective immediately and will remain in effect until incorporated into Department Order #906, Inmate Recreation. This Director's Instruction supersedes the related section of Department Order #906, Inmate Recreation, as follows:

PURPOSE:

This Director's Instruction increases the maximum number of television channels authorized on the Closed Circuit Television System from sixteen to seventeen.

PROCEDURE:

906.05 STANDARDIZED CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION SYSTEM

1.1 A maximum of **seventeen** television channels shall be provided, based on local availability, as determined by the Warden, or designee. If the capability does not exist to deliver the maximum **seventeen** channels, the Warden, Administrator or designee shall determine which of the available channels will be offered. Channels shall be selected from the following types:

1.1.1 Major Networks	ABC, NBC, FOX, CBS, etc.
Educational	Public television, Discovery, etc.
Religious (3)	Religious services, etc.
Sports	Sports-related programming
News	CNN, Headline News, etc.
Spanish	Spanish language channel
Black entertainment	BET, etc.
ADC Programs	Inmate education or religious programs
Announcements	Computer bulletin board

1.2 There shall be no premium channels, no movie channels, or ADC channels reserved for showing ADC-owned or rented movies.

1.3 The Warden or designee may shut off all or part of the institution's closed circuit television system at any time at his or her discretion.

1.4 The standardized viewing schedule appears as Attachment C.
