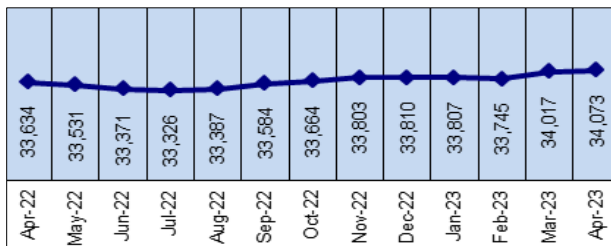

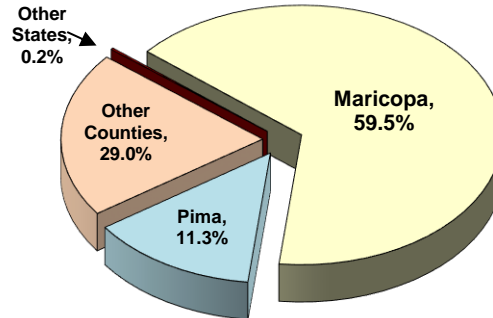

MONTHLY POPULATION CHANGE

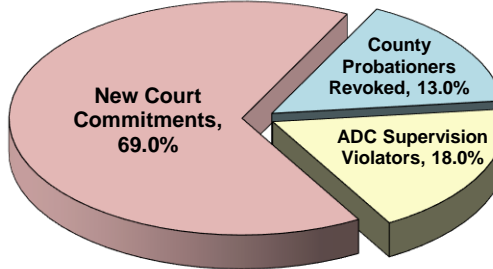


Snap-shot of Population on Last Day of Each Month

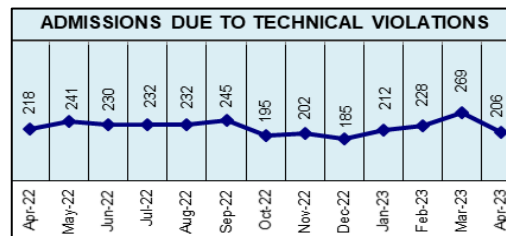
COMMITTED POPULATION BY COUNTY OF CONVICTION

ADCRR HAS RELEASED 11,716 INMATES FY 2023 YEAR TO DATE



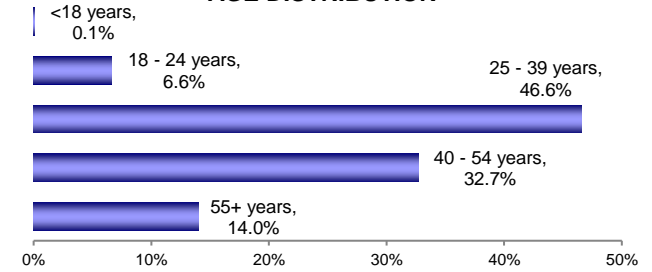

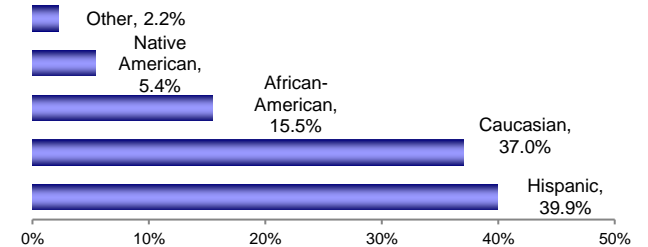
CITIZENSHIP / GENDER DISTRIBUTION

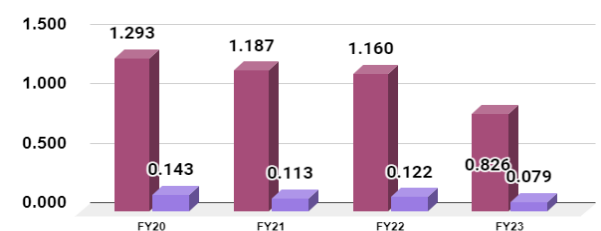
AGE DISTRIBUTION



ETHNIC DISTRIBUTION

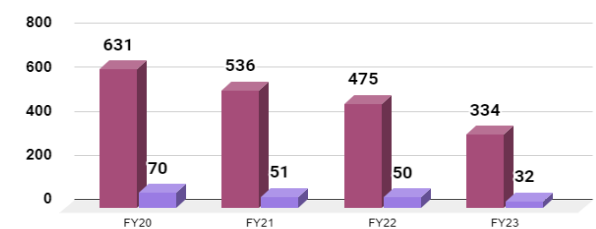


TOTAL STAFF ASSAULTED PER 1000 INMATES
